Ages 8-18 – Competition Levels

The competition levels are geared for juniors looking to advance their skills and play at the competitive level through tournaments, high school and college teams.

Bronze

Juniors improve their stroke production and begin to play out points and sets. Players understand how to keep score. Students are encouraged to play Rookie Net Tournaments.

Silver

Players continue to work on their stroke production and now are able to place balls where they aim them. They also get their first serve in most of the time. Players can rally with peers and are starting to play competitively. Students are encouraged to play Rookie Net and participate in Match Play.

Gold

At this level, players are working on their technique while learning to strategize on the court. Students are encouraged to play USTA sanctioned tournaments and Match play.

Platinum

A class geared for tournament players and high level varsity players. This class works on point structure in a live ball setting. The ultimate goal is to achieve a high USTA ranking. Pro-admit
